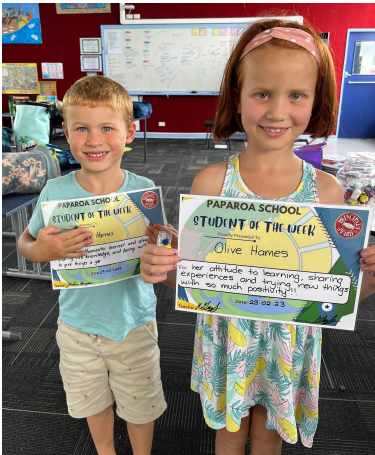

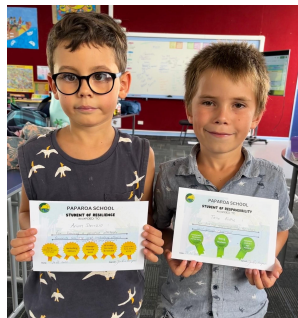
## MEASLES
