We are now in Week Five of the term and our focus turns to our BOT Kitchen Project. This is an exciting milestone as today Phase One of the project began with the inside of the building being gutted. We have had our first hiccup with the heat pump but this will be a time issue. The next phase of the project will be the plumbers coming in to install the gas and plumbing for the sinks and dishwasher.

While all this is going on we will be getting quotes from electricians and applying for grants to pay for this part of the project.

Fundraising will be the key to this project and I want to thank the parent community (Andrew, Alex, Rebecca, Glen, Dan, Sasha, Errol, Matt and Jesse) who came out and helped split up the firewood on Saturday. Also a big thanks to Moana, Ngaire, Kirsty and Julie for providing food and drink during the morning. We managed to split approximately 10 m3 and we have already sold 4m3. I am offering the wood to our parent community first, so if you would like to buy some firewood, we are selling it at \$80 per m3. We also have mulch which we are selling at \$50m3. We still have more wood to split and could do with some extra help. Put Saturday 16th March on the calendar - starting at 8am. Bring a chainsaw, axe or splitter if you have one. Just helping stack would be much appreciated.
