Welcome back to school and the 2025 year!! We have had a great start in all three classes, and what a huge difference it is to have small classes. I had my first set of teaching days on Monday and Tuesday and I was amazed at the amount of individual learning and support that could be done through the day as a result of the small numbers. How lucky are we!!

Timetable

This year we have made a minor change to the break times. Morning tea is now 10.30 - 10.50 and we have added 10 minutes onto lunch which is now 12.30 - 1.20. We found that the students spent a lot of time eating in the wharekai and were not having enough downtime out in the playground. We have trialled it over the last three school days and it has worked a treat.

Hui

Due to the inclusion of our third classroom, we are moving Hui to Wednesday afternoons so that all three classrooms are able to share their learning. Hui starts at 1.45pm and all whanau are welcome.

Taipuha Bus

Just a heads up for our Taipuha bus families. We have been told there is pine tree harvesting happening around Central Road which could cause delays, so this could affect the pick up and drop off times slightly.

Environmental

This year, all the students will be participating in our Environmental programme held each Tuesday in the first learning block. Our tamariki will be split into four groups and will rotate each week, going to either Cooking, Gardening, Ngahere or Mana Ake (wellbeing). We have developed Tuakana/Teina within the groups where the older students will mentor and support a younger student.

We ask that all students wear covered shoes (no holes !! eg crocs) on Tuesdays. All students with long hair (including our boys) must have a hair tie for cooking. My advice is to just leave one in their school bag. If you are available to help with the cooking, we start at 9.00am and finish at 10.30am. Two volunteers each week would be awesome!!
