The following week we are having a visit from Clare and Polly who are from ERO (Education Review Office). They will be in school on Tuesday 17th and Wednesday 18th June.

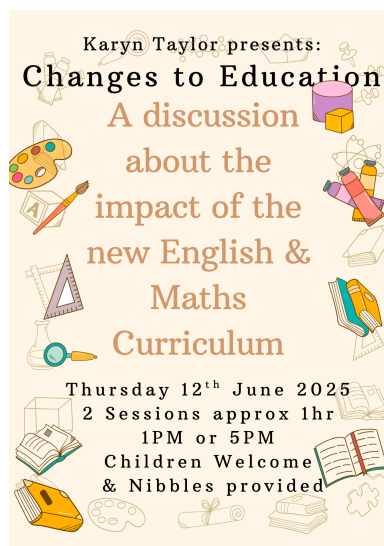
## Matariki Celebration
